Program Director for the Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility Fellowship

The Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, University of British Columbia, is seeking applications for a Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility specialist to fill the administrative position of Program Director for the Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility (REI) Fellowship.

The Division of Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University of British Columbia offers a two-year subspecialty training program in Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility. The Program requires applicants to have completed training through the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (or equivalent) in Obstetrics and Gynaecology.

The program is a structured two-year experience combining both clinical and research activities. The program is concerned with the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of those disorders of the reproductive endocrine system that interfere with reproductive health at any age, and endocrine and other conditions that interfere with the human procreative process. One subspecialty resident is selected every 1-2 years, as determined by the residency program committee, in conjunction with approval from the Office of Postgraduate Medical Education. This program meets all of the requirements for training of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada for REI Fellowship Programs.

The Program Director has the responsibility to ensure that the fellows have the resources that they need to complete this field of study and successfully complete Royal College certification in REI. This includes:

- Ensuring adequate clinical breadth and volume to develop the clinical skills required of a practicing REI specialist.
- Organizing members of the Division of REI to provide the educational curriculum to prepare fellows for practice in REI.
- Providing mentorship to help develop the skills of an academician, including pedagogy and investigation.

This position will be for a three-year term, renewable by agreement. Administrative appointments are annual appointments, renewable upon satisfactory review. The Program Director will be accountable to the Head, Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, University of British Columbia and the Division Head, Division of REI. Candidates must have a current appointment in the Division of REI. They must show a demonstrated interest and passion for education.
