The Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, University of British Columbia, is seeking applications for a Generalist Obstetrician and Gynaecologist JOB SHARE position in the Division of General Obstetrics and Gynaecology, based at BC Women's Hospital and Vancouver General Hospital. The anticipated start date is August 1st, 2018 or a date to be mutually agreed upon.

We are seeking a candidate with experience in clinical and surgical Obstetrics and Gynaecology with an outstanding track record. As the successful applicant for this position, you will have certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) and be eligible for licensure to practice from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC. In particular, we are seeking an individual with a strong teaching background and a commitment to education. You will participate in educational programs in collaboration with UBC for undergraduate medical student teaching and post-graduate resident teaching. In addition, continuing medical education for medical and other health care professionals would be expected.

As a junior faculty member within the Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology, the successful candidate will be expected to participate in teaching and service obligations, at the discretion of the Division Head of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at BCWH and VGH. The incumbent will report to the site heads of the Divisions of General Obstetrics and Gynaecology at BCWH and VGH, and to the Head of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at UBC.

This position is funded by fee for service through the medical services plan of British Columbia.
